A desk will be staffed in Renold Building during the main conference registration times

Tuesday 2 pm – 6 pm

where delegates will be able to collect keys/swipe cards for Weston and Chandos Halls.

Outside of these hours keys/swipe cards can be collected directly at the Halls or Days Hotel for Weston Hall.
